Show Fee:

There is a **\$50.00** fee for each group performing in our show. Please make checks payable to **BMMA**. Payments made via U.S. mail to the post office box address listed on the enclosed Invoice are preferred; however, payments will also be accepted the day of the show at Check-In by one of our Band Greeters. Please include a copy of the enclosed Invoice with your payment. It would be helpful if the Spiel Sheet was forwarded prior to the show; however, it may also be given to our Band Greeters the day of the show.

Staff Passes:

Please remind your staff that 2012 NESBA staff passes are required to enter the show. Any staff member, chaperone or non-performing student without a pass will be asked to pay admissions.

Admission: Adults \$8.00 / Students \$5.00

Start Time and Order of Appearance:

Please check out NESBA.org for the start time and order of appearance.

Warm up and Performance Schedule:

Enclosed you will find two timing schedules – one for Winter Percussion groups and one for Winter Guard groups.

Bus and Equipment Truck Parking:

Signs and Volunteers will be on site to assist your group to bus and equipment truck parking, and truck unloading and reloading areas. Due to limited space in our loading areas, each group will be asked not to unload any earlier than **two hours** prior to their performance time and to **reload immediately** following their performance. All performers must check-in at C-Zone 2 before helping with equipment. See enclosed map for specific unloading and reloading areas. {Note: **low bridge** on St. Paul Street if using MapQuest directions.}

Spectator Parking:

Volunteers and signs will be on site to direct spectators where to park. Per the enclosed map there is one main area for spectator parking located in Area "G-General Parking" near the Spectator Entrance.

Performers/Staff/Chaperone Check-In Area:

All performers must enter through the Check-in area to have their hand stamped as they come off their buses. The entrance for all performers, staff and chaperones is at the corner entrance that leads to the classrooms in the B and C wings of the School designated as C-Zone 2 on the enclosed map. You will then be directed to where your truck is unloading if you need to help with equipment.

All groups will have two volunteers assigned to their group from the time they arrive until the time they are done performing. These volunteers will bring the groups to their classrooms, warm up areas, gym and back to their classroom once their performance is complete.

Classrooms:

Each group will be provided with a classroom to put their belongings in. Please no eating or drinking in this area. Batteries are allowed to warm-up in classrooms with the door closed. We ask that one adult from each group stay with the performers while they are in the classrooms. There will be restrooms open near the classrooms. Please see NESBA web site for warm-up schedule – classrooms will be assigned upon arrival.

Warm-Up Areas:

Several warm up and/or staging areas will be available for your group: Auditorium, Foyer, Library, Hallways in the B and C wings, and the Band Room. Warm-up locations and times will be assigned for your group.

Concession:

Food and beverages will be available in our cafeteria beginning at 10:00 a.m.

Nurse:

There will be a nurse on duty during the entire event. She will be located at a table in the **Gym**.

Floors:

If your group does not have a floor, please let one of the Band Greeters know and we will have a floor set up for your school before you perform.

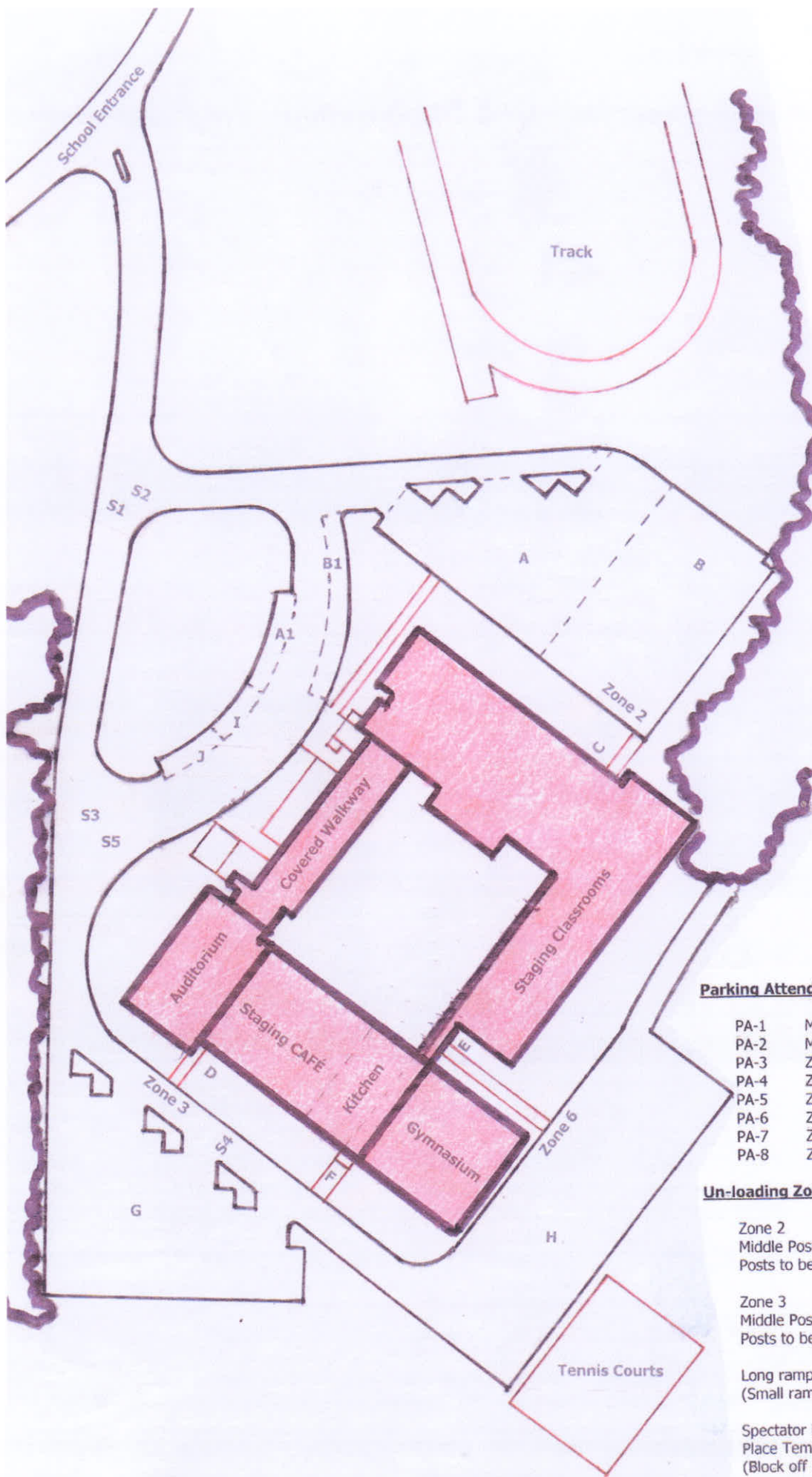

Un-loading Zone Preparation

Zone 2
Middle Post in Double doors to be removed,
Posts to be reinstalled after show is over.

Zone 3
Middle Post in Double doors to be removed,
Posts to be reinstalled after show is over.

Long ramps from Marching Band Truck to be used.
(Small ramp not adequate, too steep)

Spectator Lot – in front of Zone 3
Place Temporary "Orange" Barrels, so parking stays empty.
(Block off Lot G only, caution tape at barrels optional)

- 1. Performer entrance & Truck unload area
- 2. Truck unload/load area
- 3. Spectator entrance
- 4. Classrooms will be assigned to each school in the B Wing
- 5. Truck unload/load area
